### **JOURNAL RESOURCES**

**[Medical Teacher Twelve Tips](#)**: Series of publications offering twelve key evidence informed tips to educators on core topics.

**[Journal of Graduate Medical Education \(JGME\) "New Ideas"](#)**: 600 word articles describing novel local interventions of relevance to graduate medical education, with outcomes such as feasibility and acceptability.
